SUBJECT: CPAM 2005-0009 Revised Countywide Transportation Plan Update:
Planning Commission Draft CTP

The purpose of this memorandum is to transmit the updated draft Countywide Transportation Plan (CTP) with Planning Commission revisions. The updated draft CTP is provided for the Commission's use in both strikethrough (as compared to the 2009 staff draft CTP) and non-strikethrough versions in Attachments 1 and 2, respectively.

The updated draft document includes the revisions as requested by the Planning Commission throughout the review process and documented in the CTP Issues Matrix. Every effort was made to capture the Planning Commission's recommended changes exactly as requested in the worksessions. There were, however, in some limited circumstances, instances where recommendations from individual line items that reference the same issue were in conflict. In these instances, staff used their best judgment to resolve the issue while respecting the Planning Commission's recommendations. Staff will be prepared to address these issues as necessary at the planned worksessions in September and October, 2009.

Staff notes that certain elements of the CTP have not been included in the draft at this time. These include the list of credits, the index, and the route index. These elements of the CTP will be added as the document is finalized. Staff also notes that the Planning Commission's list of recommendations to the Board of Supervisors, and the finalized Issues Matrix and Master Issues Matrix will be provided at a later date, prior to the worksessions in September.

In accordance with the Commission's recommendations, the updated draft CTP has also been provided to the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) as called for in VDOT's Traffic Impact Analysis Regulations, as well as all neighboring jurisdictions and Towns. Notifications to stakeholders and input meeting participants are also in the process of being distributed.
